Welcome TO A VERY SPECIAL PLACE

Picture yourself exploring Cobbold Gorge, a breathtaking natural wonder tucked away within the rugged sandstone formations of North Queensland.

This gorge is vastly different from others due to its extreme narrowness, closing to a mere two metres wide in places with spectacular 30 metre walls either side. Cobbold Gorge is fed by several springs keeping the water level constant, allowing boat access even during the 'dry' season.

Delicate ferns and grasses thrive along the waterline within the gorge. Native fish flourish in these waters, plus there's a healthy population of Johnstone River freshwater crocodiles. A large variety of birds frequent the lower waterhole along with an occasional glimpse of agile wallabies.

PROTECTION FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS

Privately owned and operated by the Terry Family since 1994, Cobbold Gorge Tours and Cobbold Village is situated on a 4,720-hectare Nature Refuge adjacent to the family cattle property.

From the very beginning and to this day, the main criterion was that Cobbold Gorge Tours and Village operation be conducted with minimum impact on the environment. Visitors take guided tours through the gorge on custom-made boats with virtually silent, electric motors. In 2009 a nature refuge agreement was formalised with the Queensland Department of Environment and Resource Management. It established the 4,720-hectare Cobbold Gorge Nature Refuge, which protects a number of

vulnerable and rare plant species and forms important wildlife corridors and catchment linkages.

As you can see, the Terry family and Cobbold Gorge are all intrinsically linked, steeped in family history and tradition.

COBBOLD GORGE NOW HAS A DOUBLE WOW FACTOR

Australia's first fully glass bridge was installed in 2019, spanning the width of Cobbold Gorge to showcase a bird's-eye view deep into the narrow chasm. Enjoy the element of challenge and excitement as you test your fear of walking on glass at a height of 17 metres. It also provides an important connection to the remote western side of the gorge, capturing even more fantastic formations.

UNDARA LAVA TUBES TOUR NEW IN 2025

Cobbold Gorge is proud to advise we are conducting tours into the Undara National Park in 2025 as Undara Lava Tube Tours.

This is a place where nature's story is etched into stone. A vast underground network of lava tubes and tunnels, winding their way through and under the savannah grasslands. It's a place to learn more about Australia's geological past as you explore above and below the ground, with experienced guides pointing out key features of the tube system and surrounding landscape.

On our 3 hour Undara Lava Tube tours, you'll explore 3 or more of the tunnels, including the showcase Arch Complex incorporating the Archway, Ewamian and Stephensons Tubes and stopping of at another outreaching cave. An air-conditioned coach will take you into the National Park and our experienced guides will share stories of the history and geology of the lava tubes. On arrival it's off the bus and into the lava tube, where you'll learn more and be surrounded by the cavernous rock walls, which are marbled with mineral colours and shaped by the flow of the long-since-gone lava.

Available daily 1 May - 31 October. Tour Times 9.30am daily and 1.30pm in peak and as required. ***Child: Aged 5 to 15 years.**

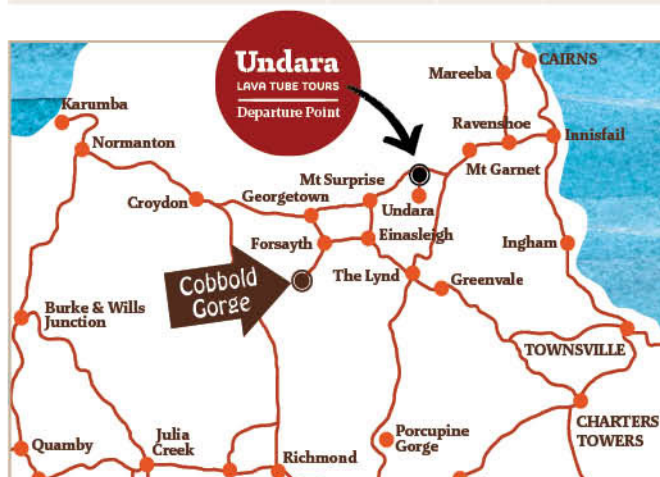
The two Savannah Way Adventure Pass tours are self-drive to the tour starting point, which is at the Undara Lava Tube Tours Departure 10kms along the Undara Road, and at Cobbold Village for Cobbold Gorge, via Forsayth. Transfers to and from the tubes and the gorge are provided and included in the rate. The tours must be completed within 7 days of each other.

To book this package select your accommodation at Cobbold Village, then select the In-House Savannah Way Adventure Pass to book the time and date for your gorge tour. After your purchase is confirmed a friendly team member will contact you to book tour times and date for your tour at Undara.

Available from 1 May – 31 October. Tours times at each location vary. Access to Cobbold Gorge and the Undara Lava Tubes is by guided tour only. Cobbold Gorge and the Undara Lava Tubes are geographically separated by some 234km of road, but you can expect the same great customer service from this award-winning team, at both attractions.

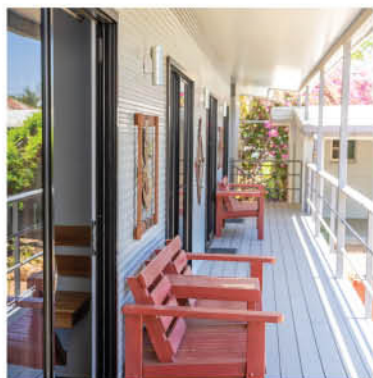

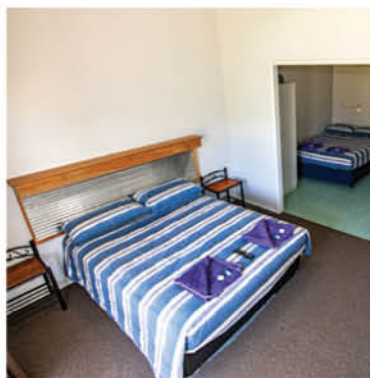

1 Charleston Dam

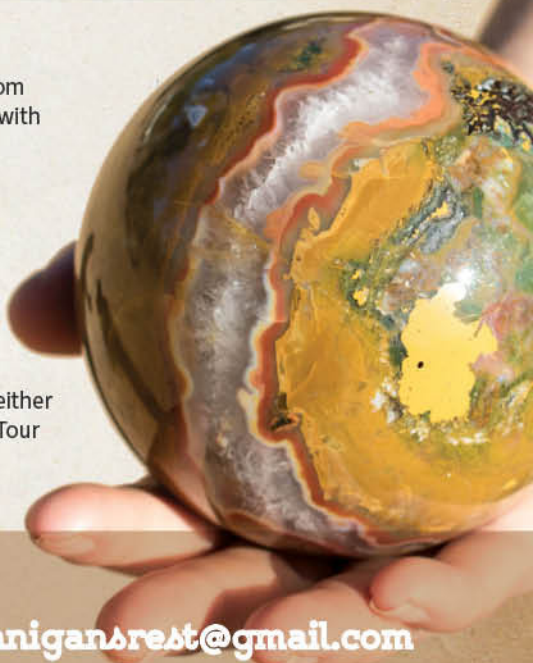
Spend a relaxing day at Charleston Dam, 4.5km from Forsayth, it provides a lovely stop for watersports with BBQ facilities and toilets.

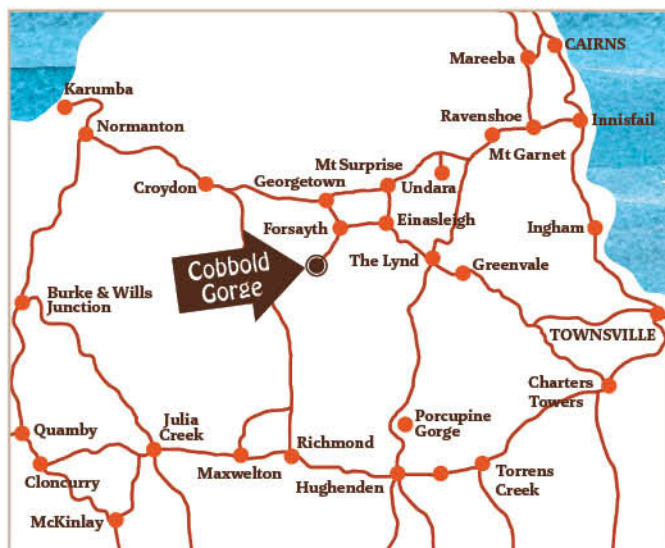
